

Administrative considerations

1. For ambulance crews who come into contact with a PUI, an assessment of exposure risk should be performed after the call. This should be reported to their immediate chain of command. F&ES personnel should follow local policy and procedures in reporting possible exposures.
2. For persons who need to complete NREMT re-certification requirements or need to schedule psychomotor skills assessments or cognitive testing, CNIC N30 will issue guidance as changes are made to the NREMT processes.
3. Navy Fire crews should attempt to distance themselves as much as possible while at work (i.e. > 6 feet between persons). Arrangements should be made to try and prevent the sharing of bedrooms and personal spaces. These suggestions are made with the understanding that this may be impractical or impossible at certain fire stations. All personnel are encouraged to exercise their best judgement.
