FIRST RESPONDERS AND THEIR ROLES



DISPATCHER

Determines Location

Rapidly Determines Appropriate Response

Vehicles: Telephone

Responsibilities:

- Collect patient health information (e.g., age, breathing, pulse)
- · Identify immediate life threats
- Give first aid instructions (CPR, bleeding control, etc.)
- Relay non-HIPAA protected information to other responders •

EMS

Patient Care

Vehicles: Ambulance, medic unit

Responsibilities:

- · Evaluate patient's medical condition
- · Carry out lifesaving work, and continue this work during transport
- Provide more advanced medical techniques
- Stop the medical emergency from progressing
- Coordinate medical assistance to patients

POLICE

Safety and Order

Vehicles: Police Vehicles

Responsibilities:

- Law enforcement
- Rapid response and early intervention (CPR, bleeding control, etc.)

FIRE

Incident Stabilization Property Conservation Vehicles: Fire Engines, Ambulances, Fire Command Vehicles

Responsibilities:

- Secure the scene
- Take action to attack fires

In many municipalities, the fire department provides EMS.





All first responders provide public safety.

Responsibilities:

- · Perform CPR or deliver first aid when first at the scene
- Ensure personal safety
- · Advise personnel in the area of potential threats relevant to their area of focus
