 - All physician-directed (& influenced) activities that support the provision of EMS care

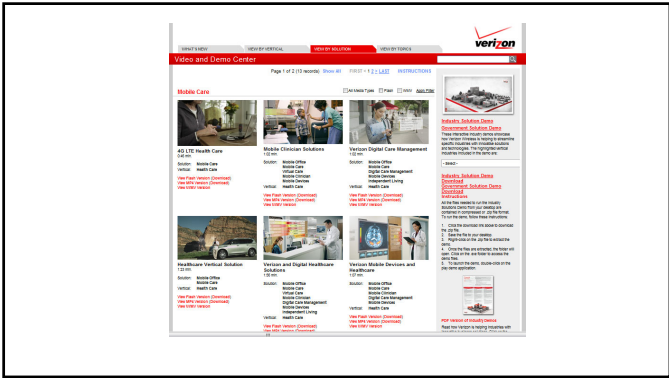
